Installing FIU VPN

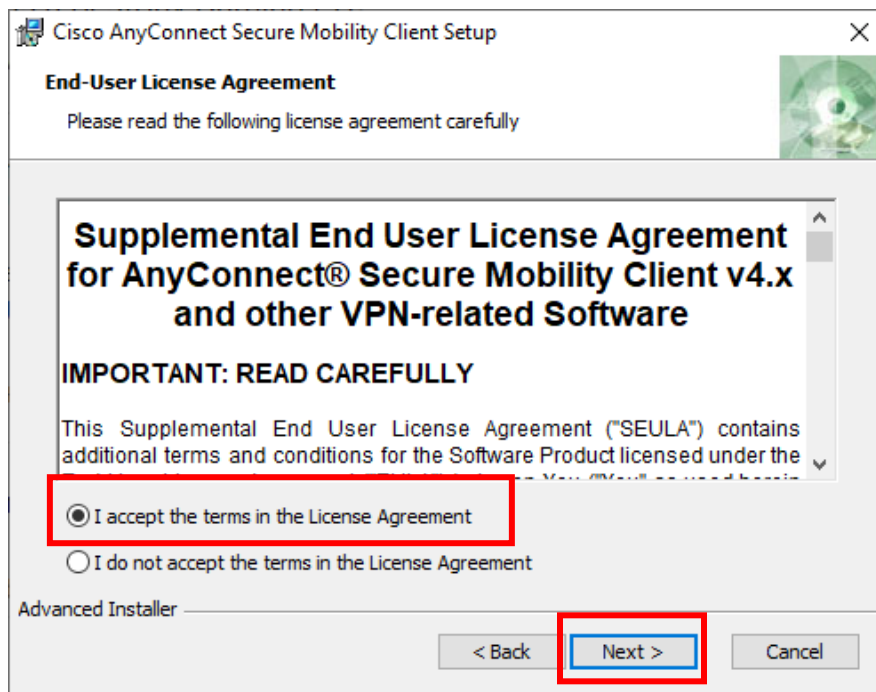
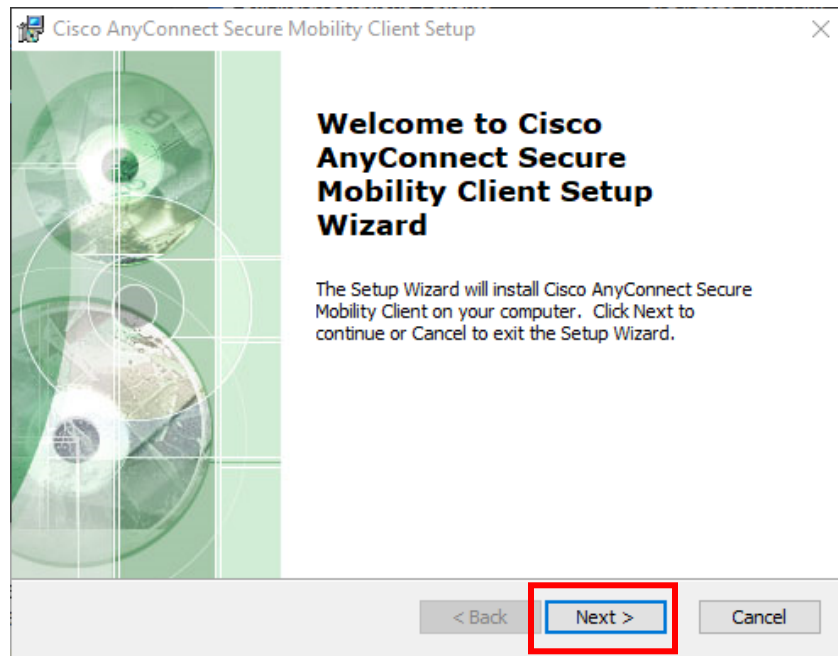

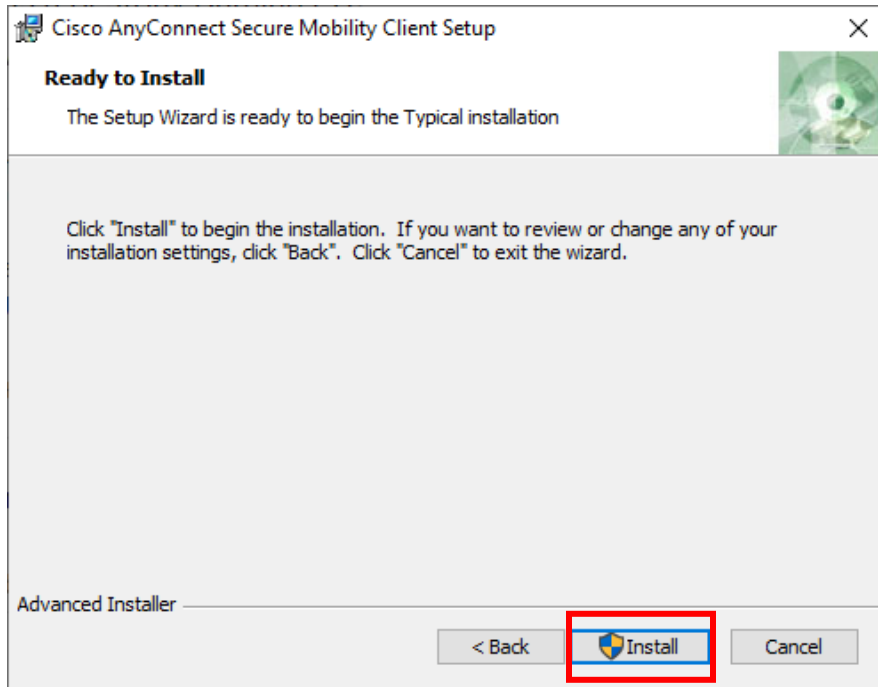

Run the **anyconnect-win** installer:

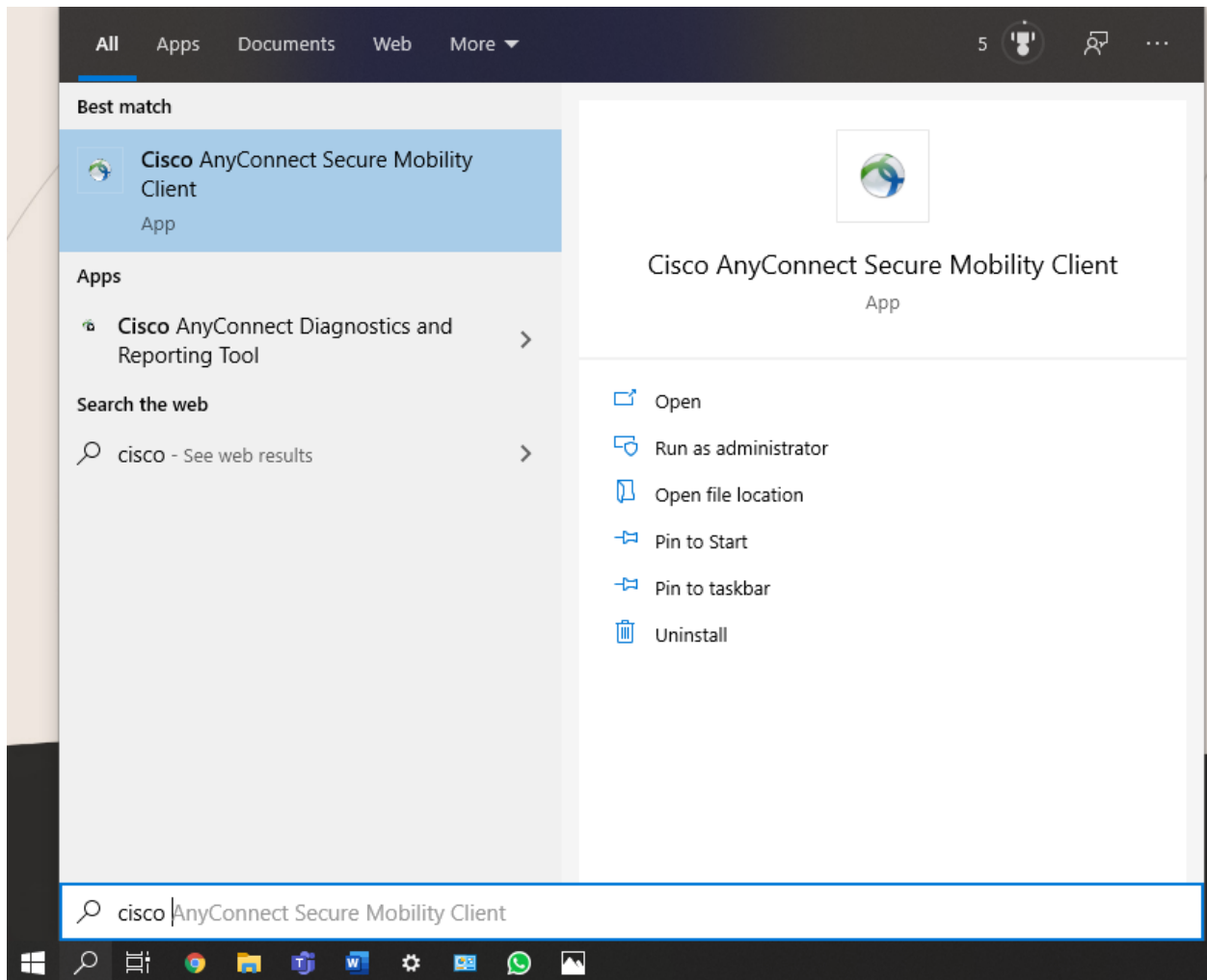




Accept if Windows/Mac ask for permission to install the VPN and then click **Finish**.

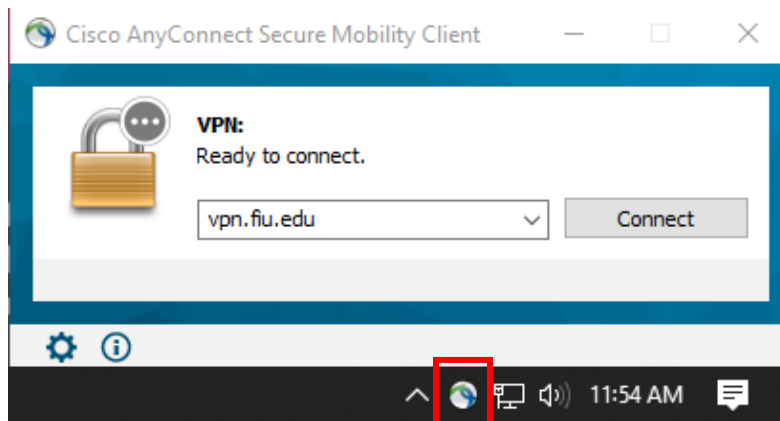
Run/Connect to the VPN

Run the Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client:




A small window should pop up, if not Right click  and **Open AnyConnect**:
